- C. Community and parent involvement benefitting students with disabilities
- D. Exemplary collaborative and inclusive educational practices benefitting students with disabilities
- E. Exemplary leadership that promotes inclusive educational practices benefitting students with disabilities

2. Grant Application

Complete the grant application form and submit along with a typed description (**3-pages max**) including the following information:

- A. Program/Practice Title
- B. Description of program/practice to include: location, history, stakeholders, and costs
- C. Program/practice goals and objectives
- D. Explanation of how program/practice is innovative/exemplary
- E. Collaboration component to include how program/practice is connected to educational community
- F. Future goals for the development of the program/practice
- G. Implementation and evaluation of the program/practice
- H. Possibilities/opportunities for replication of program/practices
- I. Include one letter of support, testimonial or success story
