

## **2018-2019 TRANSITION EXPECTATIONS**

**ATTENDANCE:** Students are expected to attend the Transition Program on a regular weekly basis, or they will be dropped from the program. If they are going to be absent, it needs to be cleared through the office.

**TARDIES:** For each minute a student is late, they will be charged \$1.00 from their classroom account. They need to be responsible. If they are going to be late, to avoid being charged, they need to call the classroom and let their teacher know that they will be late.

**BEHAVIOR:** Our classroom is a safe and positive environment that encourages learning and growth, In order to make sure that this happens, **there are certain things that will never be tolerated or allowed: bullying, put downs, and inappropriate language.**

Our classroom will use a **Money Economy** system to encourage students to have good behavior, to make good choices, and to learn how to budget. **Behavior that is disruptive to learning will result in a loss of classroom money and privileges. Behavior that is disruptive to job sites may result in being removed from a job site.**

**DRESS CODE:** When students go to job sites, they need to be dressed appropriately – **Nice pants** (jeans or khakis - unless they are working sat Fitness 19 or Sunflower Hill),their **Employee in Training work shirt** (which will remain on campus), and **closed toed shoes, and a belt if their pants have belt loops.** (If students are NOT dressed appropriately, they will not go to their job site). **Students will also need to wear their student ID badge on their lanyard anytime they leave campus.**
